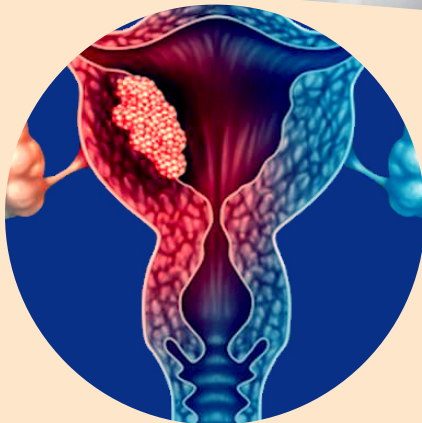


CANCERS IN FEMALE REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

SYMPTOMS

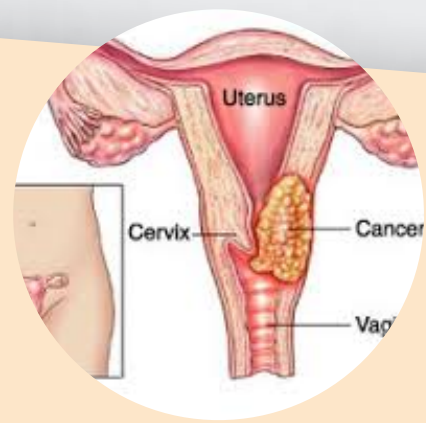
VAGINAL BLEED AFTER MENOPAUSE
BLEEDING BETWEEN MENSTRUATION
PELVIC PAIN

RISK FACTORS

AGE > 50 YEARS OLD
HORMONAL IMBALANCE
PROLONGED MENSTRUATION YEARS
OBESITY
NO PREVIOUS PREGNANCY
TAMOXIFEN FOR BREAST CANCER
HEREDITARY COLON CANCER

PREVENTION

BIRTH CONTROL PILLS
COMBINED HORMONE REPLACEMENT
THERAPY
MAINTAIN GOOD BODY WEIGHT

6.8% OF NEW CASES IN FEMALES IN 2020 WERE CERVICAL CANCERS

SYMPTOMS

VAGINAL BLEEDING AFTER SEXUAL
INTERCOURSE, BETWEEN MENSTRUATION, POST
MENOPAUSE
PER VAGINAL DISCHARGE, FOUL SMELLING
PAIN DURING INTERCOURSE

RISK FACTORS

MULTIPLE SEXUAL PARTNERS
EARLY SEXUAL INTERCOURSE
WEAKENED IMMUNE SYSTEM
OTHER SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASE
DIETHYLSTELBESTROL (DES)

PREVENTION

HPV (HUMAN PAPILLOMATOUS VIRUS)
VACCINATION
REGULAR PAPSMEAR
NO SMOKING
SAFE SEX
